

May 1873.

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Friday 1st The men went with Geo. Herbert and others to Waikiki returned to lunch, then went down street to get a tin for cake to send to Geo. This eve the Benet has fled in the yard. I get calls from Capt Davis, Mrs. White & Fanny, Mrs. Barrett, Mrs. Black, Mrs. Dickens and daughter, so I have done but little work today.

Saturday 2nd Went down street this morn. have worked on my dress since. have nearly finished it. The Northern Light sailed today. I sent a letter by Capt Smith, the Anwarat, Hagle arrived today with 3 bottles sperm and a bucket of whale oil. Mr. Smith out, Capt Hayes stops here, I have written to him tonight.

Sat 3rd The first Perry and James Kelly sailed today also the S. Costa Rica for San Francisco, I went down on board the Locomotive with Mrs. Herbert, Kathi has passed the day with George Smith. I dine with Mr. Wither Mrs. Jane Smith, Mrs. Owen and Mrs. Smith have dinner this eve also Mrs. Lambert. I have finished my dress feel quite pleased with it.

Sunday 4th Went to Sunday School and meeting at the Bethel this morning. heard Father Dorem preach from Dent 8th & 9th c. This eve went to Lot 14 with Mrs. Black and Mrs. Owen, heard Rev. Mr. White preach from Romans 14th & 15th c. Capt Hayes of the Anwarat came home with us, I have just written a letter to John Smith to send by the Murray before

Mon 5th

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This morn. went down street after the afternoon called on Mrs. C. H. Lewis, Mrs. Castings, Mrs. Bolles and Mrs. Robert. After dinner we started for Waikiki to stop the remainder of the week. It is perfect here. Mrs. and I anticipate much pleasure by stopping here. We have three sleeping rooms. Mr. & Mrs. Herbert and Mr. occupy one. Clara and Mrs. Kathi and I the other. Bobo has a bed on the floor in Clara's room. We have a Chinaman for cook and another for waiter. Mr. Herbert will go to town every morn and take Kathi and Clara to school and take them back at night.

Tues 6th

This morn. and I have passed the day very pleasantly. This afternoon several of the officers from the Calaputia called to bid Mrs. Herbert goodbye. Lieut. Wilson passed the eve taught his sailors and played several games. Had a call from Mr. & Mrs. C. H. Lewis. This morn. rec'd a call from Mrs. Wetheroff and Miss Whitney. We watched the ship of war cut this morn. The S. C. Muddy has sailed for San Francisco. Mrs. Black came out with Mr. Herbert tonight will go back in the morn. Mr. Lane and Mrs. Babcock called this eve.

Wed 7th

This morn. while sitting at breakfast discovered a steamer coming that proved to be the Inboard, Mr. Herbert
