very much. it is much larger than  
the one I have been occupying. This  
eve have finished two pairs of pants  
for Fannie and eight for Fannie.

Fannie on board the Marine Star  
to call on Capt. and Mrs. Haulton.  
The eve have spent in my room, but  
an invitation to go to a marriage

dinner party this eve. His Majesty  
June was present.
