not seem very well. has had a sleepless
fever about a week. This afternoon I went
down to Dr Camargo Homeopathic and
got some medicine for him. This eve called
on Mrs Barrett and went to Bethel for a
meeting Capt and Mrs Lelette brought
me home.

Thurs 5th Went last eve to the Hop on board the
Patoomba with Mr and Mrs Herbert and
Owen. Went at six returned at eleven
passed a very pleasant evening. Due to
honor of being presented to King Lunalilo
and he took a seat beside me and
conversed some time I felt highly honored.
Luthie have been working on my jeans.
Lith. tonight immediately after dinner
went with Mrs Herbert and Mrs Barrett
to call on Mrs Whittens. took Luthie with
me he does not seem very well.

Sat 7th Went down to the Post Office this morn.
to mail letters to Luthie Sam Ann's
and Mrs McKingie. Since then have been
working on my dress. The Skimmer sailed
at 12 M. Capt James went. also Mr and
Mrs Gilman and Lieut Smith. I thought
just as I finished my dress Mrs
Whittens called and took Luthie and
I out to ride.

Sunday 8th This morn went to Bethel Street to
dinner from Rev Mr Forbes from
the West So. I am with you always
even unto the end of the world.
This eve went with Mrs Owen and Mrs
Lambert to Bethel. It heard Rev Mr
Alexandros preach the annual Home
Missionary Sermon.

Monday 9th Worked on my dress this morning.
This afternoon at three o'clock went
with Mrs Lambert and Mrs Owen
down to the Moring Star to attend
the services given to the sailing
Kono men. Three large banners
are American flag. by the white
churches. (East St & Bethel) Mr Whittens
made the presentation speech. The
Hawaiian flag from the Native Chiefs,
presented by Rev Mr Bishop and as
signal flag. a blue grained with
white stars. The vessel sailed at
four. Capt Hallett taking his wife
with him Mr and Mrs Pringham
are passengers to the Liberty Bell
and Mrs Park. also the will
return in the vessel. This eve. went
with Mrs Owen to call on Mrs Dancens and
Mrs Black.
