eve. can hear the band very nicely here.
Stanny Smith called today.

Feb 23rd 1884. Linnahut on Tues this morn this
afternoon have been helping Mrs
Herbert arrange flowers for a dinner
party given by the Prince the American
Minister there were eighteen invited
dinner were present. I recd an
invitation this morn for the Kings
Ball. Mr and Mrs Herbert invited
me to go with their party so
I am provided with an escort.
The Band from the English Man-of-war
played in the yard during the
dinner from six until seven. I
went to friends meeting this eve
think it the most interesting
one I ever here attended in Honolulu.
Mar 26th Have been down street with Mrs
Herbert several times. She has
been made me a present of a very
pretty scarf for the neck. I spent it
yesterday with a white dress and
pink sash. Lillian will sleep in Clara's
room until I return.

Wed 27th Went to the Ball. found a very pleasant
eve. the palace was illuminated
beautifully with about 100 Chinese
lanterns. a spacious dance hall.
was well filled with where the
Kings Band and the Band from the
Republic performed the music. we
but stopped at twelve. cold drinks of all

kind's salads, jellies, cakes, and minis
of all kinds. Great respect to
Mrs Herbert and I were together all
the eve. Rev Mr McIntosh escorted
Mrs Herbert to supper and the Rev
Mr Lutton Chaplain of the Republic
escorted me. we came home at one
this morn at ten went by invitation
to Dr Smiths to pass the day. Mrs
Herbert with baby and nurse and
Lillian and myself. Mr Herbert came
with to dinner at five. we returned
at seven. found the dinner party
so I had to walk a plank to get
into my room tonight.

Sat 28th

This morn went down to Mrs Barrett
to tell her that I was summoned
by point and have her just from
her visit until Monday. returned at
at ten o'clock went to Waikiki with
Mr and Mrs Hallard and two children
and nurse Mr and Mrs Simsen and
children and nurse Mr and Mrs Herbert
nurse baby and Clara. Mr Killgore
Mr and Miss Gibson, and Stella Wills
returned at five then went to Emory
Square at five to hear the band play
this eve called at Mrs Druncus and
Mrs McGraw with Mrs Herbert. Mr and
Mrs Black called this eve.

Sun 29th

This morn went to the Bethel. Father
Linnahut preached from Psalms 137.
This eve went to Fort St James the Rev
Thompson from Hale. kept this hope we have
which is like an anchor to the soul
both here and at Stuttgart.
