30th

Have done considerable mending. Made a scarf of a piece of silk Mrs Dr Smith gave me and finished my tuck. Mrs Barrett came up and passed the afternoon with me. I walked down as far as the Belton with her when she went home.

Aug 1st

Have made an underwaist for myself. This afternoon Mrs Herbert and Clara Smith and I went to ride rollers on Mrs Daniel Smith and Mrs C.E. Williams. This morn Mrs Herbert has been to the getting party of Mr Dickson and Helen Holden. The reception was at the house of Jackson Dickson Esq. I had a invitation but had a slight acquaintance with the parties. Mrs Duncan called at the church tower and asked me to come down there this eve so I went for a little while.

Aug 2nd

This morn went down street with Mrs Herbert. This afternoon Helen Whitney and Miss Buckman passed with me and I went to prepare meeting with them this eve. Mrs Black came home with me to wait for Mr B to call her when he came from Leeds.

Aug 3rd

The Costa Rich arrived this afternoon from S. E. I have rec'd but one letter that was from Charlie Riggs. This afternoon went with Mrs Caird and Mrs Smith to call on Mrs Price. This eve went to the Theatre with Mr Herbert and Clara to hear Mary in *King Lear*. Mr and Mrs Mathew arrived from S. E.

Aug 4th

This morn the Antiques and Fossils from the struts. They made a fine show. This afternoon I went with Mrs Herbert to the

Mrs Make & a reception at Dr McCreus. This eve went to a small party at Mr H. M. Whitney's. Mr Whitman called. Mrs Barrett Mrs Black and myself and Emily's as back. The American Mission gave a collation to gentlemen here between twelve and two. Emily has been firing crackers nearly all day. Mr Price gave him twenty five cents and Mrs Owen and I each gave him the same. He has signed the book and fortunately has not met into the accident.

Oct. 5th

Have spent the day mending and doing odd jobs. This afternoon drove down street with Capt and Mrs Make and Mrs Herbert. This eve went to a party at Capt Make's, returned before eleven as I could be in bed before twelve.

Nov 5th

This morn went to Bath, S. E. and meeting. Received a sermon from Rev Mr White. This eve went to St. E. heard a sermon from Rev Mr Thompson of Hills Top. Mark 5/14. Mr C. left David Smith, wife and daughter came almost home with me.

Nov 6th

Have finished my waist. Mrs Chess called this eve. Mrs Dr Smith and Mrs Atkinson called this morn and Mrs Herbert and I went down street in their carriage with them. Mrs Make and Bellie must have taken also Mrs Ansell.

Nov 8th

This morn went to the Office to mail letters to L. J. L. and Kate Waller. Afternoon called on Mrs Bannister's sermon
