The Costa Rica sailed today 12th. This morn at ten went down to Mrs Duncans with Lulla, came home at two and decided then Mr Herbert sent Frank to drive me to Mrs Carters passed a very pleasant afternoon, as well as evening. Came home to friends meeting with Mr and Mrs C. have just returned with Lulla and Jack from in boat, the J.A. Falkenberg arrived last night from S.H. with three dead white mice. Made the trip in eleven days. Just one letter from Lella.

This morn went out to Mrs David Smiths to pass the day, but a pleasant visit. George brought his home, have been working on my deed.

Friday 14th Mrs David Smith called this morning and wanted me to go with her (to make some calls. I went. we called at Mrs Lellies but did not find her at home called at Mrs Joe Carters and Mrs Lullies. This afternoon went by invitation to Mrs Barretts. Spent the afternoon Mrs B came home with me. The choir rehearsal here. I sang the hymn was here until 10th and I

have written twelve pages to send to George, and shall write some more in the morning.

Sat 18th Capt. Weston of the Haraway called this morning, at home Mrs C. Mrs Smith and I went to carry our letters and papers down to Mr Bolles since he sent me word this morn he would put the letters on board if we would send them to him. But we met George Mc Charles who offered to take them seeing that they were the Banks agents and he would give them to the Capt with the ships papers. So we gave them to him. This afternoon I called on Mrs Bolles, found her quite well.

Sun 18th Went to Bethel this morn. Mr Danner preached from Hosea 2nd 22nd. This afternoon went with Mr and Mrs Black to Dr Jewells funeral. They spent here and Mrs Black went to meeting with me at the First St. heard Mr Thompson preach from Luke 21st a part of the 26th verse. They always Mrs Washhoff called on me at home.

Mon 17th This morn cut out three chemises one night dress and a pair of drawers but just finished cutting when Capt Lellie called and said he was obliged to go to Fairbanks on business and asked if I would like to ride down. I accepted the invitation for Lulla and I we called at Mrs Washhoffs while he attended to his business, and when he was
