Fri 31st Spent the morn working on Lullie's clothes. Heard of the death of Smith Brown. she was buried this P.M. at 4 o'clock. I went out to call on Mrs Mattheu and Mrs Pack. With Mrs Herbert returned and went to farewell with Mrs Owen and Mrs Porter. This eve the choir rehearsed here.

Sat 1st Went down to Mrs Duncans a little while this morn. We then have finished Lullie's other suit and made some stockings at five P.M. We and Mrs Polles expect for me to go to ride with them I went with Lullie with me Mrs Black passed the day here

Sunday 2nd This morn went to Pali. I was in the choir. Mr Darren preached from the high. Come for all things are ready. This eve went to West St. with Clara Mrs Black and Dr Brooks. heard Mrs Thompson preach from 2nd Kings 5th 18 & 19

Mon 28th Have passed the day at home cutting and making a muslin Polonaise for myself. (Capt Selitt called to invite us to go to the Pali tomorrow)

Tues 29th This morn at nine o'clock started for the Pali. Lullie Pierce took Mrs Smith, Lullie and myself in her carriage Mrs Owen went with Capt and Mrs Selitt, but a pleasant day we took our lunch with us. returned about three P.M. very tired.

Wed 30th Have cut out three pairs of dresses and stitched them up and done a little mending. This eve went to Pali to prayer meeting Mrs Black went and came home with me. I still feel very tired. have not recovered from the fatigue of yesterday. Mrs Herbert is going around

Thurs 31st Went to Mr Poles this morn to pass the day. Capt and Mrs David Smith were there I had a pleasant ride after lunch Mrs Cole and daughter Lullie took us for a drive out to the Laeave before This is a Kanaka mule. The anniversary of the restoration of the flag & Union was
