Mrs. McFarlane has passed the day here. I could not go up to check today it is the first time I have failed of going since we came in port. Lohi has been absent from Sunday School for the first time. I have written two letters to Sydney and Kate & go to the Mission on Tuesday.

Monday 24<sup>th</sup>

Have passed the day sewing on a white sack. Dr. McEwen called to see us this P.M. Mr. Barrings and Dr. Dr. of the Mission man of our school, took dinner with us. Luthi commenced going to school today.

Tues 25<sup>th</sup>

Have finished my wash today. This eve Mrs. Herbert and I called on Mrs. Werthoff.

Wed 26<sup>th</sup>

Put out my grass linen dress today and sewed a little on it. Mrs. Spier and Harrie came down late. Mr. Herbert & I slept with her and Harrie as the Surge. Luthi slept with Clara.

Thurs 27<sup>th</sup>

Have been at work on my dress. Mrs. Daniel Smith has passed the day with us. Capt. Smith came down and passed the eve.

Friday 28<sup>th</sup>

This is baby Lucy's first anniversary. The birth has been celebrated by a Luau or Native feast consisting of a roast pig

cooked in two leaves made jam, fish potatoes Poi bread butter cake, like Champagne, wines of different kinds, all the beverages from the hotel, all the servants, Clerk and wife, Mrs. Leplat and family, Mr. and Mrs. C. H. Lawrence, Dr. McEwen, and Capt. Elliott. This eve Mrs. Werthoff and family have been here. Mr. Lane and Mr. Barchus came down late. This eve we had an ice cream party. Baby had several very handsome presents. All the children Luthi included have passed a very happy day.

Sat 29<sup>th</sup>

Have been sewing all day. This P.M. had a call from Mrs. Col. Spalding of Maui. He with her husband arrived by Dr. Kilawee this morn.

Sunday 30<sup>th</sup>

This morn Clara Luthi and I went up to meeting came back about two o'clock.

Monday 31<sup>st</sup>

The Steamer Costa Rica arrived this morn. I rec'd a letter from Lohi and one from Miss Robinson of St. Thomas. Capt. Laffage called this eve brought Mrs. Herbert a box of California Paches and Peas. Mr. Whitman also called. Mrs. Herbert went up to town this morn returned at twelve. I have been made sick all day, have not set up but little but better tonight. rec'd a letter from Kate Miller.

Tues 1<sup>st</sup>

Have again finished my dress. Col. & Mrs. Spalding dined with us. This eve Clara and I went up to play matron. I rec'd four papers from Sydney today.
