Sun 21st Went to Bethel this morn to Sunday School and Morning Service heard a sermon from Mr Lumsden. Went to East St. this eve. Mr Lumsden preached from Jonah ch 1. 2nd & 3rd & 4th & 5th & 6th & 7th & 8th & 9th & 10th & 11th & 12th.
