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Wed 8th Have had a pleasant day with little
 wind and what we have is much about.
 Sat 13th 13th have for the day by Sofa Pillow and
 Sun 33.50 Commenced a watch case basket with
 white beads. Have seen a Brig Sloop
 Southward. My Pine Apple is in bloom
 Mon 9th Have had a small day. Have seen
 five sails. The greatest of which was
 under some south. I have nearly finished
 my watch case. It is very dark and
 thick and light is quite sharp
 Tue 10th Have had quite a pleasant day
 I have finished my watch case and
 Sat 18.41 commenced a Slipper case. Have
 Sun 36.48 seen four sails and have outdied
 the others were going the other way
 Sat 17th Have had a fine breeze with a light
 breeze. This morning saw a vessel at
 long distance ahead of us. steering the
 same as we are. At half past two
 this afternoon we passed her. Exploring
 Sat 17.38 signals met Longitudes. She was the
 Sun 34.48 Algeria of Porto Portugal. She long
 was far seen miles west of us, and
 according to that we were in only four
 fathoms to twenty fathoms of water
 sounded and found seventeen fathoms
 from her appearance she was only a
 few days from port. as the Port bell
 was not heard and no Royal yards
 aloft. as the Longitudes of all the
 vessels seen have been small ships
 and some long also agree Post has
 changed the rate of our clock to correspond
 with them. I have been making
 on my slipper case. we have left the

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Algeria almost out of sight from the deck
 off our lee quarter.
 Sun 12th Have had a pleasant day with light
 wind. think we have now got the
 Sat 15.55 S E breeze and hope to make a good
 Sun 37.50 passage to the line. Have spent the day
 making make a current Puffing machine
 Mon 18th Have had quite a pleasant day. I
 Sat 14.00 have spent it working on my Slipper
 Sun 36.55 Case have nearly finished it.
 Tue 19th Have a good breeze and a pleasant
 Sat 18.28 day I have finished my Slipper case and
 Sun 36.50 commenced embroiling a watch case
 with black silk on straw color cashmere
 Wed 16th Have had a very small day. with
 Sat 9.49 quite a heavy swell. a sail is in
 Sun 34.30 light brought off the lee quarter
 going the same as we are. I have
 finished the watch case and commenced
 a Slipper case for the 11th.
 Thurs 16th This morning we got up very early and left
 off towards land raised if seen after
 daylight ran along the shore making
 Pernambuco city and light. found our
 off Pernambuco commenced twelve miles east so have
 added the 48 seconds to her rate and
 until her at four seconds last year day.
 we put a good view of the city
 down our sail off shore from the
 going the same way we are the going
 in to the harbor and in or out small
 sloops over the shore. Have been making my
 Slipper case.
 Fri 17th Have had quite a pleasant day with light
 Sat 14.6 variable winds this afternoon wind from N.E.
 Sun 24.44 The vessel we saw yesterday. was in sight this morning
 have finished this Slipper case. except the English light
