Sat 18th This morn. had some cake, that proved very nice.
 Lat 2 25^S Since then have made a pair of Shoonie moccasins
 Long 35.48 Sump mats, and mended several garments.
 Nothing in sight, heading N. N. E.

Sunday 19th Have had a pleasant day with a light
 breeze. I made a Duff for chimney
 and a clam chowder for supper.

Sat 20th 3rd have spent the rest of the day making
 Long 35.85 nothing in sight, a few Skiffjacks
 around tonight.

Monday 21st Have had a pleasant day, a shower
 of rain this morn. that lasted but few minutes.

With I have commenced making a chemise
 Sat 2. 00th gale that Mrs David Smith gave me
 Long 36.14 the morn we left Thule. George has
 been working on a Hammock.

Tues 21st It has been calm all day. Pleasant in
 the morn but frequent showers this

Wed 22nd afternoon I have been working in my
 garden commenced a Soap Book last
 night have fasted in a few pieces

Wed 22nd Have had a squally day with very little
 wind and that is about. Leo has finished

Sat 3. 00th the Hammock and I have finished my
 Long 38.01st gale and commenced making the chemise
 have fasted a few scraps and given
 my Bureau Lopez & the second coat of
 varnish.

Thurs 23rd I have just finished my Chemise. I
 made fruit pie this morn. we have had

Sat 4. 34th strong N.E. trades today both then and
 Long 40.32 night they are well matted as we are

on the wind heading N. N. W. the
 morn. of the time seen a sail from
 West. was last seen off our bow

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Sunday 24th I have been quite sick with morn
 headache all day. it is a little easier
 Sat 6. 54th tonight I have had but little and
 Long 40.42 have done no work. It has been quite
 sunny. The water also off several of my
 plants last night.

Sat 25th My head is better but still troubles me
 Sat 26th I made some Sugar Cookies this
 Long 43.9th morn and some warm Scones for tea.

Have completed a hair pin box cover
 and made the box. this afternoon have
 commenced embroidery a pair of slippers
 for Ophelia. It has been sunny all day.

Sunday 26th This morn made two Pumpkin pies and
 Gooseberry pies and a plum Duff.

We had a very rough night. one wave
 came over the deck high and a large

quantity of water came into the Cabin.
 Long 45.23 The tide rips yesterday were very strong.

Sometimes the water would be very
 smooth around us and at other times
 would be such a tide of white water
 it almost looked like a reef. Saw
 a school of Pilot fish yesterday and
 another today. One morn from July
 before I be near here with a bucket
 of White Spar Oil.

Thurs 30th I have spent the week thus far working
 on capers. Slippers finished them tonight

19 26 Sat we have had rough weather all the
 55.16 day. seen a few porpoises and

skipping fish and are a two mile some
 distance from us. Saw Gull west by.

Sunday 30th May day here I would like a nice burst
 of May showers from the stormy north when
 I used to gather them when a child.
