Have had another very rough day here
seen nothing could not take it if we
had. It has threatened the coast of land

Sat 33rdSun 11th 12

1821

Time for two days and the weather had
looked bad so Capt. has decided to cross
to Gulf before for better weather to
the Southwest. Squalls in the gulf
about two o'clock. and are now strong
Dr. R. W. saw the sails going off and
have had a pleasant day we are now
at six o'clock about midway of the
Gulf Stream. The wind is variable and
the barometer falling. it looks as if
we may have nothing more. we have
been very busy all day jacking and
making ropes. here now every thing faster
that we can do until almost in port.
Hope one week from today to reach and
more the shores of my native land

Sat 36th 30Sun 1st 14

1822

Saw the sails this evening
I have seen hard at work all day cleaning
our state room, and jacking and mauling
the spurs the work today went very
slightly damaged he looks them over
and says they I made a case for them
and helped to jack them. and ordered
is in good order and ready for him

Sun 1st 18Sat 37th 48Sun 2nd 50
