

# Remarks on Board Ship King

Outward bound 1851

Saturday Oct. 25. All of these 24 hours  
fine breezes from N. N. W. steering S.  
by E. by compass. (Lat. by Obs. 25° 53' N.  
(Long. by Chron. 28° 26' W.)

Sunday Oct. 26. Breeze with fine breezes  
from N. N. W. steering S. by E. Middle  
and latter part the same (Lat. by Obs. 24° 08'  
(Long. by Chron. 27° 46' W.)

Monday Oct. 27. All of these 24 hours  
light breezes from N. N. W. steering  
S. by E. (Lat. by Obs. 22° 35' N.  
(Long. by Chron. 26° 50' W.)

Tuesday Oct. 28. All of these 24 hours  
light breezes from N. N. W. steering  
S. by E. (Lat. by Obs. 20° 58' N.  
(Long. by Chron. 25° 47' W.)

Wednesday Oct. 29. Breeze with light breezes  
from S. W. Middle part the same  
latter part light airs from S. (Lat. by Obs. 20° 05' N.)

Thursday Oct. 30. Breeze with light breezes  
from S. heading W. S. W. to S. W.

Friday Nov 2nd 1851. Commences with fine  
easterly breeze middle of it with  
last part S. by East steering S. by West  
raised a sail right ahead at 1 P. M. on our  
lee beam. It ends this day (Lat. by Obs. 18° 37' N.  
(Long. by Chron. 25° 19' W.)
