

Monday Nov 2. 1851

Days out 31. These 24 hours commenced with fine breezes Easterly steering first part S. by West, middle part S. East part S. by E. by East at daylight raised a sail right ahead at 12 M. she was on middle beam so was the day. Set by Obs 13.32 N. Long. 164.25 W.

Monday Nov 3. 1851

Days out 32. These 24 hours commenced with fine breezes E. N. E. steering S. by East today set main top sail and dispoil saw a bark bound N. West and two sails bound South. Starboard watch took turning up. Main rigging and wearing new lanyards. So ended today. Set by Obs 11.14 N. Long. 164.26 W.

Tuesday Nov 4. 1851

Days out 33. These 24 hours commenced with quite strong E. N. East breezes. Steering steering S. by East last part Easterly breezes with rain. So ended today. Set by Obs 7.04 N.

Wednesday Nov 5.

Days out 34. These 24 hours commenced with E. S. East breezes quite strong at 3 P. M. raised fore & Main top sails at 6. more moderate from S. East we set white top sails at 3 P. M. bound for Blackfish Cann and boat got one the first part we had rain moderate and later part light breezes from S. East to E. S. S. Ship heading S. S. West to S. Some of men making top sails and the first mincing Blackfish. Set by Obs 4.50 N. Long. 164.22 W.

Thursday Nov 6. 1851

These 24 hours commenced with light breezes E. S. E. middle part we had a heavy fall of rain with a shift of wind from E. to South and then it hauled back to N. and continued throughout very light steering S. four sails insight from a South so ended the day. Set by Obs 7.00 N.

Friday Nov 7. 1851

Days out 35. These 24 hours commenced with light and variable breezes from all parts of the compass working ship smoothly watches doing very well some setting in potatoes as the day. Set by Obs 6.07 N.

Saturday Nov 8. 1851

Days out 36. These 24 hours commenced with very light breezes and calms with rain. Starboard watch watch time. Putting up a new fore top galley and setting up the main stay. Starboard watch setting up the Main rigging, putting up the larboard main top and back stays two ships on sails in sight so ended the day. Set by Obs 5.45 N. Long. 164.21 W.

Sunday Nov 9. 1851

These 24 hours commenced with very light breezes and calms middle and later part light from E. S. E. to S. E. Ship heading from S. S. to S. N. by S. at 7 P. M. spoke the bark Family Jane of London from Bombay to London. So ended today. Set by Obs 5.13 N.
