

Remarks in Voyage of Ship Mary
In Kamtschatka Sea A.D. 1750.

Wednesday May 5. These 24 hours
light winds from N.E. W. with fair
weather. First part steering N. 100 N. N.E.
middle part under short sail heading
East by S. Last part heading from
N. N. W. 15 N. N.E. Lat by Obs 57. 32 N.

Thursday May 6. All through
these 24 hours light winds from N.E.
sailing ship N. East by S. Summed with
Ship Child of N. Bayna
Lat by Obs 57. 42 N.

Friday May 7. These 24 hours first part
light winds from N.E. middle and latter
part moderate from N. W. steering N. N. E.
to N. E. First and last part fine weather
middle part it snowed some. Lat by Obs 58. 24 N.

Saturday May 8. These 24 hours
commenced with fine weather steering
by E. Middle and latter part light winds
and calms with snow squalls. Several
sails insight

Sunday May 9. First part of these 24 hours light winds middle
part fresh winds from N. W. 15 N. W. N.
steering N. E. with fair weather
Lat by Obs 59. 36 N.
Long. Chron 17. 43 E.

Monday May 10. These 24 hours
first part moderate breeze from N. 100 N.
steering N. E. middle and latter part
light winds and calms. At 8 P.M. spoke
Ship Es. Washington of N. Bayna
Lat by Obs 60. 06 N.
Long. Chron 17. 58 E.

Tuesday May 11. These 24 hours
first part calms middle and latter
part strong winds from N. N. W. 15 N. W.
steering N. N. E. at 8 P.M. spoke
Ship Es. by S. for a while they found down
the wind heading N. E. latter part
snow squalls ship heading N. on one
tack and N. E. on the other. At 8 P.M.
saw ice and were run from it. Snowed some
Lat by Obs

Wednesday May 12. These 24 hours
moderate winds from N. N. W. with snow
squalls and heavy or light drizzling to and
fro heading East by S. and West by S. small
quantities of ice all around the ship. Spoke
Montpelier of N. Bayna two whales
this season. Lat by Obs 59. 53 N.
Long. Chron 17. 32 E.

Thursday May 13. Throughout these
24 hours moderate winds from N. N. W. 15
N. N. W. first part a steering N. East by S.
along the ice. At 2 P.M. steered N. N. W.
N. W. Several sails insight a going in all directions
Lat by Obs 59. 14 N.
Long. Chron 17. 42 E.
