

Wednesday June 23. These 24 hours
fast part calm middle and latter parts
light Westerly breeze turning Northerly
At 8 am landed for Bunkers Harbor
boat struck 90 fath line hauled the boat
under water and cut from him. Saw a
considerable field ice. Wind still night
have a falling We finished boiling today
turned up on ice 25 Seal.

Thursday June 24
These 24 hours moderate breeze from
Westerly lying along the ice. Fast and
middle part clear weather. Latter part
thick fog. Landed three times for Bunkers
without success. Spoke ship Nagara for 15
6 whales. Wind still 1 whale.

Friday June 25
All of these 24 hours moderate breeze
from N. to N. and E. with thick fog.
Landed the day.

Saturday June 26.
These 24 hours fast and middle parts
moderate breeze from E. and thick
fog. Latter part calm weather. At 4 am
struck a Bow Head whale by 6, got him
alongside and at 10 am had finished cutting
with strong breeze from N. N. E.

Sunday June 27.
All of these 24 hours moderate gales from
N. Shipman shot sail a laying to heading
N. W. by N. and E. N. E. employed in tiling
Sat by 100 40 N.
Long 179.20 E.

Monday June 28. Sunday June 29.
All of these 24 hours moderate gales from
N. Shipman shot sail a laying to heading
N. W. by N. and E. N. E. employed in tiling
Several seals night.

Monday June 28.
All of these 24 hours strong gales from
N. by E. Ship a laying to under close reefed
main topsail and of sail heading N. W. by N.
and E. to E. N. E. We saw a number of Bow Heads
employed in tiling. Sat by 100 40 N.
Long 179.20 E.

Tuesday June 29.
All of these 24 hours
strong gales from N. heading N. W. by N.
and E. to E. N. E. Ship under short sail
we finished tiling and stowing down.
The two whales making 100 N. The day
more with rainy weather.

Wednesday June 30.
All of these 24 hours strong gales
from N. by E. under short sail a laying to.
Middle and latter part light breeze
from E. to N. Saw several Bow Heads a
going to E. E. At 12 noon struck one to W.
and landed. Weather foggy and rainy.

Thursday July 1.
These 24 hours
moderate breeze from N. Middle and
latter parts mild from N. N. W. with
more or less fog. Landed three for whales.
Bow Boat struck and landed.
