

Remarks on board Ship Navy

Wednesday July 21

Throughout these 24 hours winds from N.E. to S.E. made double reef a square heading N.E. Easterly employed in stowing down all on the starboard side in the after hatch. Saw two or three whales a going quick.

Thursday July 22

The first part of these 24 hours winds from S.E. to S. with more or less fog & making ship to Northward. We lowered the Bonnet but without success. Employed in filling and stowing down in after hatch the day.

Friday July 23

All of these 24 hours light and variable winds with more or less fog. Saw one or two whales a going quick to the Northward.

Sat by Act 44. 48 W.

Long. 176. 4 W.

Saturday July 24

Throughout these 24 hours light and variable breezes from all parts. At 6 P.M. finished filling. At 2 P.M. lowered the Bonnet but without success. We finished stowing down in main hatchway on the starboard side.

Sunday July 25

All through these 24 hours light and calm from all parts of the compass with some fog. Sailed for ten hours pulling without success. Several sails insight. The most of them a chasing

Monday July 26

All through these 24 hours light and calm with thick fog and a plenty of whales going to Northward employed in reaping time.

Tuesday July 27

All of these 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. N. to S.E. with thick fog a backing to on fore heading S.E. to E. and N.W. employed in reaping time.

Wednesday July 28

Throughout these 24 hours moderate winds from S. to E. N.E. making ship to Northward. First part quite fair weather. Sailed twice for whales. Whales and latter part thick fog and rain.

Thursday July 29

All of these 24 hours moderate breezes from E. to S.E. a backing to and for with rainy and foggy weather. Spoke ship N. P. Tallmadge of Cadesburg & whales this season made her 500 W.

Friday July 30

All of these 24 hours more or less fog. At 9 A.M. raised a whale board and struck and by 12 noon had him alongside. We closed up all the sails and dropped anchor and commenced cutting King Island might some 25 miles distant.

Saturday July 31

The first and middle parts of these 24 hours strong breeze from Eastward. Finished cutting by 8 P.M. Sailed for whales a going quick. At 8 am. took anchor
