

Friday September 10. Bore out of the Arctic with strong breezes from N. W. heading from S. E. to S. by East. At 10 A. M. made East Cape bearing per compass S. by West. By 12 noon ahead of it. Ten sails in sight hauled out. We was twenty days inside and got but one whale.

Saturday September 11. Throughout. Heavy strong winds from N. W. to N. N. W. Bore out in company with ten sails. Took our anchor on the bar and stored cable. Lat by Obs 63.44 N.

Sunday Sept 12. Comes with fresh breezes from N. N. W. to N. E. by N. heading S. S. W. by S. by N. Spike spoke Narwhal of Holmes Hole. Lat by Obs 61.43

Monday September 13. Fresh winds from N. East by S. heading S. S. W. employed in splitting scraping and washing line. Lat by Obs 59.29 N. Long by Chron 179.26 E.

Tuesday September 14. Comes with moderate breezes from N. E. to N. heading S. S. W. employed in scraping line. Spoke the Diffusion of Sag Harbor. Ten sails full weather cloudy. No Obs.

Wednesday Sept 15. First and middle parts moderate breezes from N. to N. W. steering S. W. by S. to S. N. latter part light breezes. Lammed with ship's No. 10 of Fair Haven 12 whales this season. Took the foremast Studding sail employed in scraping and washing line.

Thursday September 16. First part light breezes from N. W. middle part calm. latter run as from S. to S. E. increasing heading S. N. employed in scraping and washing line.

Friday Sept 17. First part moderate breezes from S. E. heading S. N. Middle and latter part strong breezes from S. E. to E. N. E. At 7 Dark. doubt used for up sail at 9 P. M. new ship heading N. N. E. at 12 night new heading S. E. At daylight made sail steering. By 10 A. M. made the island of Utten bearing per compass S. Some twenty five miles distant. We passed to Westward of it some ten miles distant. Lat by Obs 53.09 N. Long 171.40 E.

Saturday Sept 18. Comes with fresh winds from E. to N. E. steering S. E. employed in drying line. Lat by Obs 51.07.
