

Thursday Oct 21. All hands
employed in cleaning out between decks.
Stowing down water and beating off from
the shore. One sail arrived today.

Friday Oct 22.
One watch on liberty and the other
watch employed in getting off a raft
of water. More or less rain all through
the day.

Saturday Oct 23.
One watch on liberty and the other
on board employed in painting.
Four ships arrived today and three
sailed from here.

Sunday Oct 24.
Starboard watch on liberty. Three ships
arrived today.

Monday Oct 25.
One watch on liberty, employed in beating
water from the shore and drying and
bundling line.

Tuesday Oct 26.
One watch on liberty and the other
employed on board ship in getting
off a raft of water from the shore and
potatoes from a schooner.

Wednesday Oct 27.
One watch on liberty and the other
employed in painting ship. Drying line
trading with the natives.

Thursday Oct 28.
One watch on liberty and the other
employed in getting off water.

Friday Oct 29. One watch on liberty
and the other employed in drying
and bundling line.

Saturday Oct 30.
One watch on liberty, employed on board
of ship in bundling line. Two men
deserted from ship. The natives were
to be on board by 3 P.M. but Jos. Thos
and Thomas Gream (the boat) did
not make their appearance.

Sunday Oct 31.
Starboard watch on liberty. James
Jones deserted. Fair weather throughout
the day.

Monday Nov 1.
All hands employed in drying
and bundling line and discharging
it on board of the bark Magdalena.

Tuesday Nov 2.
All hands employed in discharging
line on board of bark Magdalena
222 bundles or 26,400 lbs. The cork
came on board at 12 noon.

Wednesday Nov 3.
At 12 noon the bark came on board. The
sheet made sail with light custody
breeze heading out of the harbor.
Lat by obs 20.51 N.
