in the North Pacific Ocean Dec 1852

Friday December 17. These
four hours light breeze from N. N. E.
heading E. Easterly. Employed
in ordinary work. Sick as follows
down Dec. Lat by obs 20. 41. 07
Long by Chron 109. 56. 47.

Saturday December 18. All
these twenty four hours light winds
and fair weather from N. N. E.
heading E. to S. E. Employed
in ordinary work. Lat by obs 20. 42. 00
Long by Chron 109. 48. 47.

Sunday Dec 19. These twenty
four hours light winds from N. to
to E. N. East. S. E. to E. N. E.
Lat by obs 20. 41. 07
Long by Chron 108. 00. 47.

Monday Dec 20. These twenty four
hours fine breeze from N. N. E.
to N. W. heading Easterly. At 10 AM
took in light sails. Handed up coals
Lat by obs 20. 14. 07.
Long by Chron 107. 09. 47.

Tuesday Dec 21. These twenty four hours
light N. Westly winds heading S. E. by E.
Employed in painting spars. Deemed quite
sick. Lat by obs 19. 56. 47.
Long by Chron 106. 40. 47.

Wednesday Dec 22. Throughout
this day fine breeze from N. N. E.
heading S. E. by E. Employed in
painting spars. Lat by obs 16. 58. 47.

Thursday Dec 23. All of these
twenty four hours light winds
from N. N. W. with fair weather
heading S. E. by E. Employed in
painting spars. Lat by obs 15. 01. 07.
Long by Chron 103. 23. 47.

Friday December 24. Throughout
these twenty four hours light winds
and fair weather employed in painting
heading S. by East. Lat by obs 13. 41. 07.

Saturday December 25. (Christmas)
These twenty
four hours fine breeze from N. N. E.
with pleasant weather heading
S. by East. Employed in ordinary
work. Lat by obs 12. 51. 07.
Long by Chron 105. 53. 47.

Sunday Dec 26. Throughout this
day fine breeze from E. N. E. steering
S. by East. Lat by obs 11. 08. 07.
Long by Chron 106. 12. 47.

Monday Dec 27. Light winds
from N. to N. N. E. with fair weather
steering S. by E. 1/2 E. Took one sail
from Westly. Lat by obs 9. 54. 07.
