

Remarks on board of ship Navy

1853.

Wednesday Feb 2. All hands employed in sitting up shrocks and beating off and on the shore. First part strong southerly breeze, in the some rain. Latter fresh from West.

Thursday Feb 3. All hands employed in raising shrocks. Fair weather with light breeze.

Friday Feb 4. All hands employed in sitting up shrocks. To wind today.

Saturday Feb 5. All hands employed in raising shrocks. Left the ships company goes on shore every night after supper.

Sunday Feb 6. Most all hands ashore. All anything a doing on board ship.

Monday Feb 7. All hands employed in breaking out for shrocks and in sitting up shrocks. Sent eight casks of bread on shore at sundown one watch on liberty.

Tuesday Feb 8. All hands employed in raising shrocks with fair weather one watch on shore after sundown.

Wednesday Feb 9. At 9 a.m. all hands employed in breaking out oil out of the fore hatchway. Broke out some on the at 2 P.M. all ready to discharge.

while at anchor in the Harbor of H. H.

Thursday Feb 10. All hands employed in unloading oil and hauling along side of the ship Cephus to discharge oil. At 2 P.M. had ship moved ahead and astern.

Friday Feb 11. All hands employed in discharging oil on board of ship Cephus. Discharged 40 casks today.

Saturday Feb 12. All hands employed in discharging oil on board of ship Cephus. Discharged thirty one casks.

Sunday Feb 13. The most of the ships company on shore. Fair weather.

Monday Feb 14. All hands employed in discharging oil on board of ship Cephus. Discharged 40 casks.

Tuesday Feb 15. All hands employed in discharging oil on board of ship Cephus. Discharged forty casks.

Wednesday Feb 16. All hands employed in discharging oil on board of ship Cephus. Discharged thirty three casks. Finished discharging. One man sick with the fever.

Thursday Feb 17. At daylight off from ship Cephus and moved on. All hands employed in getting off water and in fitting ship.
