

Sunday March 20 Laying off and on
at Attu in company with three ships with
strong N. Easterly breeze Capt on shore

Monday March 21 Laying off and
on at Attu with strong N. Easterly breeze
with more or less rain and wind squalls.
At 5 P.M. split the jib from head to the foot.
Unbent it and bent another in its place. This
day got from shore 8 boat loads of food.
30 lbs of sweet potatoes and a few pigs.
Capt came on board in the last boat

Tuesday March 22 Laying off and
on at Attu with strong N. Easterly breeze
with squalls of wind and rain. It proved
to hard to land.

Wednesday March 23 Laying off
and on the N.E. part of Attu. At 5 P.M. split
fore topsail from foot to the foremast. Bent
it down and bent another. At 10 A.M.
Capt went on shore.

Thursday March 24 These twenty four hours
first part a laying off and on at Attu. Capt and
one boat came on shore. At 5 P.M. came off with
some twenty bags a few pumpkins and fowl.
First part fresh breeze with light rain squalls. Weather
heading S.W. to N. Lat by obs 21.20. N.
Long. chron 160.27. W.

Friday March 25 All of these twenty four hours
moderate from N. W. to S. W. First part heading
More or less rain all through the day. Lat by obs 22.15.
