Thursday April 7. All of these twenty four hours moderate breeze from N.E. with fair weather steering N.W. by N. Employed in mending. Cooks employed in setting up Shooks and Husben employed the last of the day.

Friday April 8. All of these twenty four hours light breeze from N.E. to E. N.E. steering N.W. with fine weather employed in picking over the potatoes & setting up Shooks. Lat by obs 24.23.00

Saturday April 9. Comes with moderate breeze from N.E. to E. N.E. with fair weather steering N.W. Employed in sending down fore top g. and binding another in its place Cooper at work a setting up Shooks. Lat by obs 24.25.00
Long. Chron 171.59

Sunday April 10. These twenty four hours first part light N. Easterly breeze latter from E. to N. steering N.W. at 4.00 m. raised 2 right whales. Covered for them three times without success. Spoke the bark Neptune of N. London nothing this sea.

Monday April 11. These twenty four hours light breeze from N.E. to E. Middle and latter middle and latter parts from S. to S.W. steering N.W. with thick fog.
