Thursday April 14. All of these twenty
four hours fresh winds from N. to N.W.
with squalls of wind and rain. Ship under
double reefed topsails heading N. by N.
to N. by E.

Friday April 15. The first part
of these twenty four hours winds from
N. to N.W. rather more moderate heading
N. by N. to N. by East.

Saturday April 16. Throughout these
twenty four hours winds from Westward
W. by S. to N.W. Ship to make close reefed
main top sail and main topmast staysail.

Sunday April 17. Throughout these 24
hours strong gales from N.W. heading

Monday April 18 1853. These 24 hours
first part moderate from N.W. to N. heading

heading N.W. At 6 P.M. a lightning
under close reefed main top sail a laying

to N.

Thursday April 21. These twenty
four hours first and middle parts
moderate from N.W. by N. to S.W. latter light
breeze from S. steering N.W. Employed
in setting up pipe shores. Lat by obs 46° 24' N.

Friday April 22. First and middle parts
of this day breeze from Southward and Middle and
from S. by N. and N.W. by E. heading N.W.
Lat by obs 45° 00' N.

Saturday April 23. Moderate from N.W. by N.
to S. with some snow. Latter from S. to N.
