

Monday Augt 1st First part a heading
S. Easterly. Latter moderate from West wind.
About one half of the time it is thick fog
working ship Westerly. Lat by obs 67.22 N
Long. chron 164.30 W.

Tuesday August 2nd Moderate Westerly
winds a heading S. S. W. to S. W. It is foggy
about one half of the time. Lat by obs 66.48 N
Long. chron 165.11 W.

Wednesday Augt 3rd Moderate winds
from N. to N. W. heading from S. to S. W.
on one tack and N. to N. E. on the other.
More or less fog all through the day.
Lat by obs 66.05 N.

Thursday Augt 4th Winds from N. W. to N.
a heading N. E. to N. N. E. Latter part of the day
a steering N. to N. W. Thick fog most all day.

Friday Augt 5th Moderate winds from N. to
N. E. a heading N. W. to N. N. W. with thick fog.

Saturday Augt 6th Winds from N. E. to
E. First and middle part a heading N. N. W.
to N. by E. Latter part N. W. by N. First part
thick fog. Latter part clear weather. Lat by obs 65.12 N
Long. chron 170.40 W.

Sunday Augt 7th Fresh Easterly winds
a steering N. W. by N. At 1 P. M. Spoke the
Dutch ship Joseph Hayden with two whaling boats
to the Westward. Saw insight to the Northward
of us. We luffed ship to the wind a heading
S. by E. under double reefed topsails.

The ice barrier in Lat 70.50 N. at 5 P. M.
Lat by obs 69.26 N. at 6 P. M.
Long. chron 171.52 W.

Monday Augt 8th Moderate Easterly winds
a heading S. At 10 P. M. luffed ship a heading
N. E. to E. Latter part winds from E. S. E. to S. E.
At 10 P. M. saw some field ice to the Northward
of the ship. Tacked ship so as to pass clear of it.
Lat by obs 65.49 N.

Tuesday Augt 9th Strong winds from E. S. E.
to E. N. E. First part a heading S. to S. Middle
and Latter a heading N. At 9 P. M. saw 1 Bow Head
a going quick to East E. We luffed but without
success. Lat by obs 65.47 N.

Wednesday Augt 10th Light Easterly
winds a heading S. E. to S. S. E. on one tack
and N. W. E. on the other. About 1/2 of the day
foggy. Saw 1 Bow Head and luffed but
without success.

Thursday Augt 11th Light Easterly winds
with some fog heading from S. E. to S. S. E.
on one tack and N. W. E. on the other.
Employed in filling casks with salt water.
Lat by obs 67.34 N.

Friday Augt 12th Moderate winds from
E. to N. E. a heading S. E. to E. by N.
Thick fog most all of the day. Saw several
Bow Heads and luffed but without success.
Lat by obs 67.35 N.
Long. chron 170.05 W.
