

Sakima Oct 17 1853

Monday 17. At 12 noon took shoes
and made sail and at 4 P.M. cast
anchor at base of the watering place
in 20 fathoms of water

Tuesday Oct 18. All hands employed
in getting off water and painting ship
and breaking out to see what provision
we have in the ship. Took John Henry
to the Hospital sick since April last.

Wednesday Oct 19. All hands employed
in getting off water and painting ship

Thursday Oct 20. All hands employed
in getting off water and provisions of 4
bbls flour 11 bbls of beef and 150 pumpkins

Friday Oct 21. All hands employed
in painting ship and stowing down water
and in getting our gear stowed ready for sailing
up

Saturday Oct 22. One watch on liberty.
Discharged Christian Kanakas and one Portuguese
get two bag loads of wood from shore.

Sunday Oct 23. One watch on liberty

Monday Oct 24. One watch on liberty
employed in drying bone and bundling bone
hired two men from shore

Sakima Oct 25

Tuesday Oct 25. One watch on liberty.
employed on board ship in drying and
bundling bone. There is but few men
on board ship of former hands

Wednesday Oct 26. One watch on liberty.
Employed on board ship in discharging
bone on board of ship Lydia of T. H. Am
59 bundles of bone 6756 lbs all in good order

Thursday Oct 27. One watch on liberty.
Employed on board ship in setting up
rigging and in getting bread from Thomas
and getting 15 bbls of Irish potatoes.

Friday Oct 28. One watch on liberty.
Employed on board of ship in fitting and
in setting up rigging.

Saturday 29. One watch on liberty and
the other employed in getting ship stowed from
shore.

Sunday Oct 30. One watch on liberty.

Monday Oct 31. One watch on liberty.

Tuesday Nov 1st. All ready for sea and waiting
for some men that are shipped

Wednesday Nov 2. All hands on board. At 10
A.M. took shoes made sail and stood out to sea
At 4 P.M. had come on board to a to Wahu
shipped @ co's and discharged Nicka Peter
sick
