Monday Aug 30. One watch in liberty. Employed in getting provisions from shore. Two men disabled John Allen and W. P. Preston

Tuesday Aug 31. One watch on liberty and the other employed in getting off water.

Monday Feb 1st. One watch on liberty. Employed in getting off water

Thursday Feb 2. One watch on liberty and the other employed in getting head rigging

Friday Feb 3. One watch on liberty. Shipped a new Stunna today

Saturday Feb 4. One watch on liberty.

Sunday Feb 5. One watch on liberty

Monday Feb 6. All hands on board @ getting ready for sea

Tuesday Feb 7. All ready for sea. A Sandwich Island Kanaka ran away. Shipped three men. At 10 Am broke thro' at 12 made sail and fired three guns with light axis from the Northward we worked out of the harbor. At dark we stood out to sea a heading N. N. W.

Wednesday Feb 8. Light axis from N. a steering N. W. by W. at 12 noon five buxas employed in getting the anchors on the two and stowing cable. Lat by obs 35.48.0. Long 123.21.0

Thursday Feb 9. All of these twenty four hours fresh winds from S. S. W. to S. @ steering S. W. by W. employed in ordinary work. Lat by obs 32.45.0. Long 124.56.0

Friday Feb 10. Fresh winds from S. S. W. by S. @ steering S. W. by S. Lat by obs 29.51.0. Long 125.49.0

Saturday Feb 11. Fresh winds from S. S. W. @ steering S. W. by W. Lat by obs 27.15.0. Long 126.56.0
