Sunday July 12 Moderate breeze from S.E. @ steering N.W. Lat by obs 22.29

Monday July 13 Moderate N.E. steady winds @ steering N.W. with fair weather employed in making a new fly jib. Lat by obs 23.45

Tuesday July 14. Long. chron 79.10.20. These twenty four hours moderate winds from S.E. to E. a steering N.W. p.W. employed in raising shrouds mending jib painting chains. Lat by obs 24.51

Wednesday July 15 Winds from E to S.E. employed in making a new fly jib. Cooper employed in setting up mast.

Thursday July 16 Moderate winds from S.E. a steering N.W. Lat by obs 26.29. Long. chron 80.14.17.

Friday July 17 Moderate winds from S.E. @ steering N.W. by N. employed in ordinary work. Employed in setting up shrouds and in repairing mainmast. Lat by obs 27.32

Saturday July 18. All of these twenty four hours winds from S.E. a steering N.W. by W. Lat by obs 28.48

Long. chron 81.45.17. Sunday July 19. S.E. steady winds a steering N.W. by W. with fair weather. Lat by obs 29.54

Monday July 21. All of these twenty four hours moderate winds from S.E. @ steering N.W. p.W. employed in tarring down and setting up shrouds. Lat by obs 31.29.8.

Tuesday July 22. Moderate winds from S.E. to E. S.E. @ steering N.W. p.W. employed in tarring down. Lat by obs 32.19.8. Long. chron 90.39

Wednesday July 23. Moderate winds from S.E. by E. a steering N.W. p.W. Some rain employed in painting yards black. Lat by obs 33.11.8.

Thursday July 24. Moderate from S.E. by E. a steering N.W. p.W. employed in painting spars and yards. At 10 A.M. raised
