

Remarks on board of Ship Navy

Monday March 27. All hands employed in getting shooks from ship. Arrive Lopo and Shooks from shore. Calms and light winds from N.E. One man deserted while on duty.

Tuesday March 28. Fresh gales from S.E. N. All hands on board engaged to land. Got ship all ready for sea.

Wednesday March 29. Employed in loading shuck heads and potatoes from shore. Light breeze from N.W.

Thursday March 30. All hands employed on board. At 10 am. Shore and at 12 noon took anchor a blowing fresh from S.E. Ship under double reefed topsails and courses. At 4 p.m. came off on moderate made sail. Shipped three men in Mopu and came off in the boat with Capt.

Friday March 31. First part fresh gales middle squally. Latter more moderate from S.E. N. to N. N. W. At 2 noon took anchor. At 2 p.m. sent a boat ashore for the Capt and at 4 p.m. came off. Shaped our course for Oahu. At 6 p.m. a blowing fresh but misty and double reefed topsails & tacking between Moulaki and Kawaii. At 8 a.m. made sail and squared the yards and run the passage between Mami and Moulaki a heading N. W.

North Pacific Ocean A.D. 1854

Saturday April 1st. First part windless from N. N. W. @ heading N. Middle part calms a heading E. to S.E. Cal 10.21.21 N.

Sunday April 2. Light airs and calms from East to N. N. W. @ making ship. Cal 10.21.21 N.

Monday April 3. Light airs and calms from N. to S.E. At 3 a.m. off Diamond Head. At daylight stood in for the land. At 8 Capt went on shore. At 10 a.m. a calm at 12 light winds from N.E. a logging off and on.

Tuesday April 4. Staying off and on at Oahu in the fine N.E. trades. At 5 p.m. Capt came on board from the Atto. A. Storing from S.W. to N. N. W. At 9 a.m. made the land. At 12 noon Capt and a boat were on shore. My ship a logging off and on.

Wednesday April 5. Fine N.E. steady winds. First part a logging off and on. At 5 p.m. Capt came on board and put ship's course S.W. by S. At 6 am. started N. by E. Employed in dashing Carboard anchor and storing chains. Cal 10.21.21 N.

Thursday April 6. Winds from N.E. to E. N.E. with rain squalls a starting N. by S. Cal 10.21.21 N. Log chron 164.457.
