Saturday April 22. Winds from S.E. to S.W. & steering from S. to N.W. by N. Lat by obs 25 52 Long. Chron 156 10

Sunday April 23. Winds from S.W. to S.E. a steering from N. by N.W. to N.W. Lat by obs 25 52 Long. Chron 156 10

Monday April 24. Light winds from S.W. to N. and N. with light rains and cloudy weather Lat by obs 25 52 Long. Chron 156 10

Tuesday April 25. Moderate winds from S.E. to E. Latter part from S. to S.W. @ steering N.W. Lat by obs 25 52 Long. Chron 156 10

Wednesday April 26. Fresh breezes all around the compass and the most of the time rain a steering N.W. Lat by obs 25 52 Long. Chron 156 10

Thursday April 27. Fresh winds from S.W. to N. a steering N.W. to N.W. by N. Through the night double reefed topsails Lat by obs 25 52 Long. Chron 156 10

Friday April 28. Fresh breezes from N. to N. First part a heading N.W. to N.E. At 3 P.M. more ship a heading N. Employed in mending putty gallant sail Lat by obs 25 52 Long. Chron 156 10

Saturday 29. Light air and calm from N.E. a steering N.W. Lat by obs 25 52 Long. Chron 156 10

Towards Ochotsk Sea 1854

Monday May 1. Breeze with fine breezes from S. to S.W. strong N.W. Middle part the same Latter part wind hauled to the N. Lat by obs 25 52 Long. Chron 156 10

Tuesday May 2. Breeze with fresh breezes from N. to N.W. heading N. to N.W. Middle and Latter part strong breezes from N. to N.W. Lat by obs 25 52 Long. Chron 156 10

Wednesday May 3. Breeze with strong wind from N.W. heading N.W. and under short sail. Lat by obs 25 52 Long. Chron 156 10

Thursday May 4. Strong gales from N. to N.W. under short sail a heading from N.W. to N. Middle light breezes and rain. Latter winds from N.W. a heading N. Lat by obs 25 52 Long. Chron 156 10

Friday May 5. Light winds from N. to N.W. a heading N. to N.W. Lat by obs 25 52 Long. Chron 156 10

Saturday May 6. Fresh winds from N. to N.W. a heading Westward. At 5 P.M. lashed again a heading N.E. by N. Middle and latter moderate from N.W. to S.W. Saw one right whale and towed but without success
