Sunday May 7. Fresh winds from S. S. W. to S. E. with some snow at 4 P. M. took in sail and bore ship to. By daylight more moderate from N. E. with thick fog under double reefed topsails

Monday May 8. Moderate breezes from N. E. to N. W. at 9 A. M. spoke bark Shiparuss of Mystic

Tuesday May 9. First and middle parts moderate from N. N. W. to W. heading N. N. E. to N. N. W. at 12 noon commenced snowing

Thursday May 11. Fresh gales from the Westward first part a steering N. N. E. at 7 P. M. took in sail and bore to a S. S. W. to N. at 12 night more ship a heading N. E. to N. N. E. latter part a lopping to under close reefed main topsail. Lat by obs 47.57 N.

Friday May 12. First part of the day fresh gales from N. W. Middle and latter parts more moderate made sail @ heading N. N. E. to N. Lat by obs 48.34 N.
Long by chron 155.41 E

Saturday May 13. First and middle parts moderate winds from N. N. W. to S. W. a steering N. Latter fresh gales from Southward with snow a heading E. to E. N. E. at 12 noon under double reefed topsails wind increasing

Sunday May 14. Strong gales from Southward. At 6 P. M. close reefed topsails at 2 P. M. more ship a heading S. S. E. moderate winds but a very heavy sea struck ship on our larboard quarter and stove the Larboard boat into 3. Lat by obs 49.27 N.

Monday May 15. First and middle parts of the day strong gales latter more moderate from N. W. Lat by obs 49.27 N.

Tuesday May 16. Comes with moderate from S. S. W. a heading S. at 12 noon fresh gales and squally at 12 noon came through the Kurile Islands into the Ochotsk Sea a steering N. W. in company with ships Spudwell and Massachusetts

Wednesday May 17. Comes with fresh breezes. Middle and latter more moderate from S. S. W. to S. W. @ steering N. W. to N. N. W. spoke ship Timoi of Sag Harbor a cutting a right whale Lat by obs 50.47 N.
