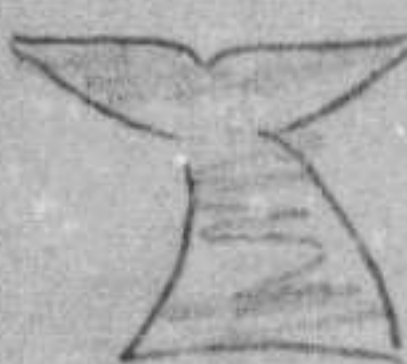


Remarks on board of Ship Nam

 Monday July 10. Light winds from E. to S. a laying at anchor whals all around ship boats a chasing all day.

 Tuesday July 11. Light winds from East to S. and calms boats off @ cruising for whals without success

 Wednesday July 12. Light airs and calms. Boats of a cruising for whals

Thursday July 13. Three brigs four boats. First part calm latter fresh winds from N.E. with some rain Ship dragged her anchor some 3 miles At 5 a.m. took our anchor a heading from the land E.S.E. At 12 noon more moderate ship under double reefed topsails Lat by obs 55.40 N.

Friday July 14. First and middle parts fresh gales from N.E. Ship under double reefed topsails a heading to and fro. Latter calms with heavy squalls

Saturday July 15. Moderate winds from N.E. a heading south West to S. Several sails insight and no whals

 Sunday July 16. Light winds from N.E. to E. At 5 P.M. came to anchor in 10 fathoms of water one mile south of Small Island. Saw whals

In the Sea of Ochotsk A.D. 1854.

 Monday July 17. Light winds from N.E. and N.W. with calms and fog a laying at anchor. First part employed in bending Starboard chain and in getting the starboard anchor off of one bow

 Tuesday July 18. Light airs and calms with fog a laying at anchor. Saw one or two whals one or two ships off whals today

 Wednesday July 19. Light airs and calms with more or less fog. Several whals insight. Looked for them without success a laying at anchor. Took anchor time wishing to remove ship some distance from the land. The wind being very light had to drop it again

 Thursday July 20. First part calms middle and latter fresh gales from N.E. a laying at anchor. Saw several whals looked for them but without success

 Friday July 21. Gales from N.E. Latter part of the daylight winds from West to S. Looked several times for whals without success. At 7 a.m. took anchor and at 9 a.m. came at anchor some four miles from shore

Saturday July 22. Light winds from N.W. a laying at anchor. At 9 a.m. BB struck a B Head and at 12 had him alongside
