

Ochotsk Sea A.D. 1854.

Monday Augt 21. Moderate winds from N.E. at 8 P.M. let go anchor about 2 miles South of Felixstow. Latter part of the day strong gales from E. to N.E.

Tuesday Augt 22. Fresh winds from E to N.E. middle part strong gales, a long at anchor. At 6 A.M. the ship a heaving and setting, sprung the palls of the windlass. Put springs on the cables and repaired the windlass.

Wednesday Augt 23. Fresh gales from the N.E. employed in repairing break to the windlass.

Thursday Augt 24. First part moderate wind and latter part of the day much the same with rain, employed in repairing the windlass.

Friday Augt 25. First part moderate wind with some fog and rain. Latter part a blowing quite fresh from N.E. At 5 A.M. hoisted short and made sail took anchor a heading of a working ship to the Northward between the mainland and Great Phoenix Island in company with five sails. Lat by obs 55.17 N.

Saturday Augt 26. Moderate wind from N.E. to E. a heading N. N. W. on one tack and N. E. on the other. Lat by obs 55.24 N.

Sunday Augt 27. Light N.E. steady winds. a working ship to windward. Middle part calm with fog. Latter light breeze from S.W. a steering N.E. to E. N.E. Lat by obs 55.27

Monday Augt 28. Moderate wind from S.E. N. to S.E. a heading E. N.E. to E. At 6 P.M. landed for stores. Latter part a strong anchors and chains. Lat by obs 55.24 N. Long. Chron 139.57 E.

Tuesday Augt 29. Light wind from S.E. to S.E. a heading from E. N. E. to E. N. employed in drying line. Lat by obs 56.13 N. Long by Chron 142.7

Wednesday Augt 30. Light wind from S.E. to E. First part a heading E. to N.E. Middle S. by N. to S. by E. employed in drying line. Lat by obs 55.41 N.

Thursday Augt 31. Moderate wind from S.E. to S. a heading from E. N.E. to E. S. Spoke the French ship La Turquoise of Havre bound a right whaling. Lat by obs 56.05 N. Long. Chron 144.28

Friday Sept 1. Moderate wind from S. to S.W. a heading from E. S.E. to S.E. by S. Lat by obs 55.16 N.

Saturday Sept 2. Moderate breeze from S.W. to S.E. a heading from S.E. by S. to S.E. Lat by obs 54.29 N. Long. Chron 145.27 E.
