

Remarks on board of Ship *Navy* A.D. 1854

Monday September 18. Moderate winds from S.E. to N.E. a heading S.W. to S. by W. Employed in mending the two Leas. One sail on sight from S.E.

Lat by obs 55.44 N.

Tuesday September 19. Fresh winds from N.W. to N.E. and W. a steering S. by W.

Lat by obs 49.17 N.

Wednesday September 20. Wind from the Westward to the Eastward a heading from S.W. to N.W. with some rain.

Thursday Sept 21. Fresh gales from E to N. a steering S.W. At 6 P.M. the ship to a heading N. to N.W. Latter light winds from N.W. a steering S.W. Lat by obs 44.12 N.

Friday Sept 22. Fresh winds from Westward a heading S.W. Latter part a steering E.

Lat by obs 41.54 N.

Long. by chron 149.25 E

Saturday Sept 23. Moderate winds from W to S.W. (a heading to and fro) Saw an Island at 8 A.M. bearing per compass N.E. One sail in sight from Westward. Lat by obs 46.06

Sunday September 24. Moderate wind from W. to S.W. a heading N.W. a laying to under short sail with thick fog.

Monday 25

Moderate winds from S.E. to S.W. First and middle parts a steering N.E. Latter part S.W. to W.

Tuesday September 26. Moderate winds from S.E. to S.W. on one tack and E. by E. on the opposite a laying to under short sail the most of the time thick fog and rain.

Wednesday September 27. Moderate winds from S.E. to N.E. with thick fog a heading to and fro at night a laying to.

Thursday September 28. Moderate winds from N.E. to N. First and middle parts a heading to and fro with thick fog a steering S.E. Spoke the bark *Vigilant*.

Friday September 29. Light winds from N. to W. with fine weather a steering S.W. Middle a laying to under short sail in company with bark *Vigilant* Lat by obs 44.33

Saturday September 30. First and middle parts light airs and calms from Westward. Latter moderate winds from N.E. to S.E. (a heading S. to S. by W. Lat by obs 47.41 N.

Long. chron 149.52 E

Sunday Oct 1. Fresh winds from S.E. to S.W. a heading to and fro under easy sail.

Monday Oct 2. Fresh winds from S.E. to S.W. (a heading to and fro) under short sail with fog and rain.
