with a light air from the westward beat
untill 4 P.M. let go the anchor in the north
passage in 12 fathoms of water at 5 light airs
from S.E. hove up and stood out clear at 12 P.M.
took the Bree of the men

March 9th this day first part moderate winds
from N all sail set to S.W. the latter from S
at 3 P.M. tacked ship to the westward at
12 Cape point bore S.E. by S Dist 20 m
thus ends

employed at mending sails

Remarks on board Wednesday March 14th
At 11 these 24 hours light winds from the
South all sail set on a wind to S.W.
employed at mending sails

Lat 35° 40' Long 15° 00' East
Remarks on board Thursday March 15th
This day first part moderate winds from W
all sail set steering S.W. & at 12 P.M. wind
shifted to S by W and a gale Double reef
at sun set wore to W by S ends strong
gales 2 ships in sight

Lat 36° 20' Long 16° 16'
Remarks on board Friday March 16th
At 11 these 24 hours hard gales from S.E.
carried all previous sail all day at sun
set took in hove to heading S.W. by W

Lat 37° 09' Long 15° 40'
Remarks on board Sat March 17th
At 11 these 24 hours moderate winds from
S.E. all sail set to S employed at
mending sails Lat 38° 52'
Long 15° 00'
