from N & a rough sea saw no whale
Lat 34° 50' Long 40° 30'

Remarks on board Wednesday Oct 3rd
This day first & middle hard gales
from SW at 4 PM wind to NW
were to NW thick and rainy
this ends Lat 35° 40' Long 40° 20'

Remarks on board Thursday Oct 4th
This day moderate winds from a thick fog
laying too under short sail Noobs
Lat by ac 35° 20' Long 40° 00'

Remarks on board Friday Oct 5th
All these 24 hours strong winds from
SW stood on a mind to W saw
no whale Lat 35° 30'
Long 68° 50'

Remarks on board Sat Oct 6th
This day first part moderate saw whale
Chased could not get past the main &
latter hard gales Lat 35° 15'
Long 68° 15'

Remarks on board Sunday Oct 7th
All these 24 hours heavy gales from
N laying too under short sail
Lat 35° 40' Long 68° 50'

Remarks on board Monday Oct 8th
These 24 hours strong winds from
SW at day light made sail to the
Northward saw no whale Lat 35° 45'
Long 68° 12'

Remarks on board Tuesday Oct 9th
This day light winds from NW at 4 PM
saw three whale bore got on Darter & mist
so ends Lat 35° 00' Long 68° 04'

Remarks on board Wednesday Oct 10th
All these 24 hours heavy gales from NW
& NW laying too under short sail
Noobs Lat by ac 35° 15'
Long 69° 50'

Remarks on board Thursday Oct 11th
This day light winds from NW at 5 PM
saw 2 whale going quick to E at 4 PM
saw one going quick to W bore got fast
and she took a line & 2 Prows to end
Lat 34° 20' Long 68° 05'

Remarks on board Friday Oct 12th
All these 24 hours strong gales from NW
spoke ship Polladium of New London
with 4 whale ship & men from her this
ends Lat 34° 40' Long 68° 54'

Remarks on board Sat Oct 13th
This day moderate winds from NW
at 10 AM saw the polladium take
whale at 3 PM saw 2 whale
bore struck both one stove a boat un-
hilled Edward Hamble instantly saw
him once under water dove down but could
not reach him took one whale along
side & let the other go sends this unfortunate
day Lat 34° 02' Long 68° 05'
