At 11 these 24 hours strong winds from
S W but in the whale saw no more

Remarks on board Monday Oct 15th
This day first part strong winds thick
and rainy at 10 AM cleared off at 4 saw
whale got on dartsed & mist at 2 finished
boiling. Xmas Lat 34° 00' Long 68° 00'

Remarks on board Tuesday Oct 16th
At 11 these 24 hours strong winds &
squally stowed down 40 lb of oil

Lat 34° 35' Long 68° 32'

Remarks on board Wednesday Oct 17th
These 24 hours strong winds from W N W
& squally. Cruised all day saw nothing but
finbacks

Lat 34° 25' Long 68° 41'

Remarks on board Thursday Oct 18th
At 11 these 24 hours strong winds & a
rough sea saw nothing but finbacks

Lat 34° 22' Long 68° 51'

Remarks on board Friday Oct 19th
This day first part strong winds from
S W and a rough sea at 10 AM
saw 2 whale looked nearer saw them
again the latter light winds

Lat 33° 35' Long 68° 20'

Remarks on board Sat Oct 20th
This day strong winds from W and
a rough sea saw nothing but finbacks

Lat 33° 30' Long 68° 18'

Remarks on board Sunday Oct 21st
This day first part moderate winds from
the westward the middle & latter strong
gales and a heavy sea saw nothing but
finbacks

Lat 34° 10' Long 68° 44'

Remarks on board Monday Oct 22nd
At 11 these 24 hours strong gales from N W
spoke ship Portland of Newbury with 2 w
saw nothing but finbacks

Lat 35° 13' Long 67° 48'

Remarks on board Tuesday Oct 23rd
This day first & middle hard gales from
N W W at 6 AM wind shifted to S W
and rain laying too under short sail

Lat 34° 20' Long 68° 00'

Remarks on board Wednesday Oct 24th
This day fresh winds from S W & E W
at 10 AM saw 2 whale going quick to
& chased them with the ship about
2 hours & banded not gain on them
keep to the north at 4 PM saw one
whale tore got part and took him
along side at sun set so ended

Lat 34° 06' Long 68° 26'

Remarks on board Thursday Oct 25th
This day comes in fresh winds thick &
rainy but in the whale and made sail
saw no more at sun set commenced
boiling

Lat 33° 46' Long 67° 52'

Remarks on board Friday Oct 26th
At 11 these 24 hours hard gales from S W
too under short reef in Tofinail employed
at boiling
