All these 24 hours hard gales from S
Laying too under short sail stowed down
50 fathoms of sail Lat 32° 33'

Remarks on board Sunday Oct 25th
These 24 hours moderate winds from
East spoke ship Ann Maria with 2 whale
got a boat steered out of hook saw 2 more
ships so ends Lat 33° 50'

Remarks on board Monday Oct 26th
All these 24 hours strong winds from
the N steering to S saw 2 humpbacks
and a shoal of hithers so ends
Lat 34° 10' Long 69° 40'

Remarks on board Tuesday Oct 27th
This day boomed in with strong gales from
N N E and hard squalls at 11 AM saw
one whale going quick at 11 AM saw
another lored and got her & cut her
in got one boat stove by the whale
running to windward No obs
Lat 34° 05' Long 70° 30'

Remarks on board Wednesday Oct 28th
These 24 hours strong winds from N N E
and a rough sea spoke ship Atlantic
of Bridgeport with 2 whale saw humpbacks
Employed at boiling Lat 34° 30' Long 70° 50'

Remarks on board Thursday Nov 1st
These 24 hours strong winds and a rough
sea laying too under short sail at 4 PM
saw a whale to leeward lored & got
her along side at 6 PM at 8 finished
boiling Lat 34° 00' Long 70° 31'

Remarks on board Friday Nov 2nd
This day strong gales from N N E but in our
whale & commenced boiling saw more whale
to leeward to leeward sent down our bottles
to repeat so ends Lat 34° 00' Long 70° 36'

Remarks on board Sat Nov 3rd
These 24 hours first part hard gales from
N N E and a fallow of rain the middle &
latter strong winds from S N E saw nothing
Employed at boiling Lat 34° 21' Long 70° 18'

Remarks on board Sunday Nov 4th
This day first part light winds comm
enced blowing down at 10 saw whale lored
and saw one the middle and latter
strong gales from N N E Lat 34° 12' Long 70° 42'

Remarks on board Monday Nov 5th
This day first part hard gales from N
at 6 AM shifted to N N E the middle &
latter tremendous gales from S N E
Lat 34° 12' Long 70° 30'

Remarks on board Tuesday Nov 6th
All these 24 hours heavy gales from N N E
Laying too under short sail at 11 PM
Lat 33° 21' Long 70° 10'

Remarks on board Wednesday Nov 7th
All these 24 hours strong winds and a very
rough sea saw whale lored could not get
fast Lat 33° 27' Long 70° 31'

Remarks on board Thursday Nov 8th
This day first part strong winds & a rough
sea the middle & latter hard gales
saw nothing Lat 33° 40' Long 70° 40'
