

Remarks on board Friday Nov 7th
This day first part strong gales thick
& rising at 12 lit up some whale lored
saw some on board again hard squalls
and heavy gales ended this day

Lat 33° 25' Long 41° 00'
Remarks on board Sat Nov 8th
All these 24 hours hard gales from
S to S by E too under short sail
saw nothing Lat 33° 06' Long 41° 04'

Remarks on board Sunday Nov 9th
These 24 hours strong winds and rough sea
at day light set sail to sea
saw whale got one but hid in
saw more got another but hid
in got through at 4⁰⁰ AM this ended

Lat 33° 16' Long 41° 46'
Remarks on board Monday Nov 10th
These 24 hours moderate weather saw
whale got one but hid in lost a
black hook employed at boiling
3 ships in sight Lat 33° 19' Long 42° 15'

Remarks on board Tuesday Nov 11th
All these 24 hours strong winds from
the Northward saw whale too busy to
be employed at storing down & boiling
Lat 33° 50' Long 42° 48'

Remarks on board Wednesday Nov 12th
All these 24 hours fresh winds saw one
whale but hid in spoke ship 4 moths
of New Bedford whaler Lat 33° 54' Long 42° 00'

Remarks on board Thursday Nov 13th
These 24 hours light winds & pleasant
stowed down 55 saw whale got one but hid in
Lat 34° 06' Long 41° 45'

Remarks on board Friday Nov 16th
All these 24 hours light winds and thick
saw whale lored some in thick some on
board again spoke ship Polladuna of New
London with 12 whale Lat 34° 10' Long 41° 30'

Remarks on board Sat Nov 17th
These 24 hours first 8 middle moderate
winds and a thick fog stowed down 55
of oil at 4⁰⁰ AM cleared off saw whale
lored darted but did not get fast
this ended noon Lat 34° 10' Long 41° 20'

Remarks on board Sunday Nov 18th
This day first 8 middle light winds
and a thick fog stowed down 55
oil at 4⁰⁰ AM lit up saw whale lored
got fast & sunk Lat 34° 50' Long 41° 48'

Remarks on board Monday Nov 19th
These 24 hours first thick fog the mid
more moderate saw whale sunk one got
fast to another she ran under the ship
the line got foul the rudderhook to boat
spoke ship Phil of New Bedford with
10 whale Lat 34° 34' Long 41° 45'

Remarks on board Tuesday Nov 20th
All these 24 hours strong gales from S by S saw
a few whale too reced to be Lat 33° 54' Long 42° 00'

Remarks on board Wednesday Nov 21st
This day first part moderate winds from
S by S the middle and latter strong
gales saw nothing but ship Polladuna
Lat 34° 05' Long 42° 03'
