& Foresail Bar at 8 hrs 30 08 00
Middle & latter parts variable winds & calms
Scho backing up towards the Port

Monday 9th

Comes in with calm weather
at 8 hrs took a breeze from WSW
at 3 hrs sent the boat in at 5 hrs the
boat returned hoisted her up and
stood out to westward in opposite tack
Bar at 8 hrs 30 02 00 Middle & latter parts strong
winds & squally weather from west, Scho
ging off & on Bar 30 01 00

Tuesday 10th

Fayal W. Islands

Comes in with strong winds & squally weather
from west at two hours the boat came off
with orders to come in to an anchor
got the chains up & bent them & at 4 hrs
came to an anchor in Fayal harbor in
13 fathoms water with Port Anchor veered
to 30 fathoms Chain latter part Employed
beating out the blackfish oil
Bar 30 02 04

Wednesday September 11th

105 days out
Comes in with moderate breezes
from S E sent in shore the blackfish oil
amounting 283 gallons. at 4 hrs let go the
Starboard Anchor & hove up the Port Anchor
Middle & latter parts fine weather. Sent the Starboard
Watch on shore on liberty

Thursday 12th

Comes in with variable winds &
pleasant weather Sent down fore
- Topmast & stowed the Rigging below
at 4 hrs received the recruits on board
viz Potatoes Onions &c &c
Bar at 9 hrs 30 03 06 Middle & latter parts
fine weather Sent the Port Watch on shore on
liberty

Friday 13th

Comes in with light winds & pleasant
weather from W. Employed in the Rigging
Middle part squally latter part good weather
Sat up fore & main Rigging both sides & filled
up three casks of salt water
