Madera dist 3 or 4 miles at noon calm
got observations for the Chronometer

Monday 29th
Comes in with light winds
from WSW at 4h Sch. steering
SE by E East end of Madera SE
per compass dist 10 or 12 miles
Bar at 7h 30.00.02 Middle part took
the Trades at SE, latter part strong trades
& rugged Sch. steering SE by E per compass

Lat 30 53 North
Longt 4h Watch 15 39 W

Tuesday October 1st
Comes in with brisk trades Sch.
steering SE by E per comp. at 4h
saw the Salvage Islands bearing
about WSW per comp
at sundown took in Gafftopsail
Bar at 8h 29.09.05 Middle & latter parts
brisk trades, at 15h hove too to E at 17h stood
off on our course, at daylight saw Lazerote
& Peurtoventura Islands bearing SE
at noon S end of Peurtoventura N.W.
