

Log of Vch. Kellie, J. Putnam of

Tuesday October 15th 139 days out
Comes in with strong breezes at 3h
Came to an anchor in the Bay &
furlled the sails, got up a tackle
& broke out & hoisted up a cask of
Oil that was supposed to leak, but
it proved to be all right. Stowed it
down again & heeled the vessel to
mend the copper, at 7h he finished
& got her righted up again
latter part strong trades stowed off
the hold.

Wednesday 16th
Comes in with very strong trades
middle & latter part much the same

Thursday 17th
Comes in with very strong trades
a heavy swell heaving into the
bay veered to 45 fathoms Port Chain
latter part more moderate set up the
fore & main rigging

Friday October 18th 142 days out
Comes in with strong trades; middle
and latter parts much the same

Saturday 19th
Comes in with strong trades and
breezy weather middle & latter parts
moderate weather

Sunday 20th
Comes in with moderate trades & good
weather At 20h got under way & steered
S.W. in company with Vch. Jason Taylor
& Albert Clacher

Monday 21st
Comes in with moderate trades but
cloudy weather Vch. steering full
in company with the two schooners
at 4h took in Gafftopsail & mainsail and
hailed down fly jib latter part light
trades with pleasant weather set fly jib &
trysail saw nothing
