Scho'r Rainbow of Dartmouth 50 days out
5 barrels sperm

Wednesday 20th

Comes in with calm weather
Saw Grampuses Middle & latter parts light
air & calm two Scho's in sight.

176 days out

Comes in with light variable air &
calms Saw Blackfish lowered the
boats & got one hoisted him in and
stripped off the bleiber & washed off,
furlled the Mainsail Middle part Scho'r
to ESE under jib & Foresail latter part
Moderate breezes from SE Scho'r steering to
SE by S Saw nothing

Lat 9 03 S
Longt per Watch 4h 21 17 00

Friday 22nd

Comes in with specially weather from
East hard furlled the Mainsail &
set the Tysail Scho'r to SE under
jibs Foresail & Tysail Middle & latter
parts Calm with cloudy weather
boiled out the Blackfish

Lat 8 50 S
Longt per Acpt 21 17 West

Saturday 23rd

Comes in with calm weather
At 4h took a breeze with rain from
SE Scho'r to SE under Tysail
Foresail & head sails latter part
light breezes from SE Scho'r steering
SE by S under all sail
