Comes in with pleasant weather
Spared down main rigging
latter part All hands Employed Ratting
Main Rigging. Taring head rigging &c

Saturday 11th

Comes in with brisk Trades &
Pleasant weather, Crew variously
Employed, latter part Pleasant
weather One watch on shore on liberty

Sunday 12th

Comes in with brisk trades but
Pleasant weather. Crew variously
Employed turned up the Starboard
boat & painted it. the above refers
to the latter part of the twentyfour hours,

of Provincetown Elisha H. Hillson Master 1858

Monday January 13th

229 days out

Comes in with brisk trades but pleasant
weather Crew variously Employed
latter part Squally with rain
To day the Brig Eastern Star & schooner
Arrived with stores for whalers but none
for us

Tuesday 14th

Comes in with ^{strong} Trades attended with
frequent squalls of Rain Middle and
latter parts much the same

Wednesday 15th

Comes in with brisk Trades & passing
rain squalls Middle part Squally with
much rains latter part good weather
unbent Foresail & Rlyfib & took them
on shore to repair them
