

Log of Whaling Bch Nellie F Putnam of

Tuesday January 28th 242 days out
Comes in with very
Strong Trades, at 1.30 came to an anchor
in the harbor of Beekun with Port
Anchor, veered to 25 fathoms & furled sails
at 5h veered to 35 fathoms
Middle & latter parts strong Trades
Set up the fore rigging & flyjib guys

Wednesday 29th

Comes in with light Trades &
frequent rain squalls Middle & latter
parts much the same.
Employed altering the Awning

Thursday 30th

Comes in with light Trades and
squally weather Middle & latter parts
much the same

Friday Jan 31st

Comes in with light Trades & squally
Weather Middle & latter parts strong Trades
but pleasant weather

Saturday February 1st

Comes in with strong Trades at 2h
got under way & stood over to
St Vincent, at 5h off Kingston Capt
went on shore, at 6h Capt returned,
took up the boat & steered for Beekun
where we arrived at 7.30, came to
an anchor in 8 fathoms water Port anchor
veered to 25 fathoms & furled the sails
Middle & latter parts strong Trades. At 22h
got under way & stood over to St Vincent
at noon came to an anchor in Kingston
Harbor

Sunday 2nd

Comes in with light Trades at 2h
weighed anchor & stood over to Beekun
where we arrived & came to an
anchor Middle part squally latter part
strong Trades, got on board two Mootloads
of Cocoonette Manches for Moom stuff
