Friday March 20th

Came in with light trades
At 4 hrs got under way & stood
over to Bequie where we came
to an anchor at 5 hrs

up the stern boat & painted it, took the
ceiling out & painted under it.

Saturday 21st

Came in with strong trades
Middle & latter parts the same

Sunday March 22nd

Came in with strong trades
but pleasant weather latter part
pleasant weather At daylight got under
way & stood out into the channel
saw whales & lowered for them in
company with the *Arizona* got nothing

Monday March 23rd

Came in with pleasant weather
At 4 hrs lowered again in company
with the "*Arizona*" but did not get on.
at 5 hrs came to an anchor in Bequie
Harbor. At daylight got under way and
worked up off the Bullet. Weather
squally with rain & strong winds
at noon came to an anchor in the lower
bay of Mustique

Tuesday 24th

Came in with strong trades
& squally weather Mate with a wooding
party on shore cutting wood.
At sundown woodcutters came
on board Middle & latter parts
strong trades & haggled weather
at 19 hrs got under way & stood out
into the channel. saw whales and
lowered for them but unsuccessfully
