Friday April 3^d

Came in with moderate trades & good weather. At 5 hrs Came to an Anchor in the lower bay of Mustique at daylight got under way & stood out on a cruise saw nothing to lower the boats for

Saturday 4th

Came in with strong trades & squally weather. lowered for whales but did not get near them. At 5 hrs Came to an Anchor in Begeed harbor. Middle part squally with rains. latter part good weather

Sunday 5th

Came in with brisk trades. Middle & latter parts much the same. At daylight got under way & stood out on a cruise. Saw whales going to quick to lower for them

Monday April 6th

Came in with brisk trades and sunny weather. At 2 hrs Came to an Anchor in the lower bay of Mustique. Went on shore with the men to cut wood. At sundown returned on board. At 12 hrs got under way & stood out on a cruise. Saw nothing to lower for.

Tuesday 7th

Came in with strong trades. All hands employed at various jobs. latter part the same

Wednesday 8th

Came in with strong trades. All hands employed at various jobs of work. Middle part heavy rains. latter part strong trades. At 21 hrs got under way & stood over to Kingstone where we came to an Anchor at about 23 hrs
