

Log of Whaling Vch Nellie Putnam of

Thursday April 8th

Comes in with strong Trades & squally weather
Middle part heavy rains. latter part strong trades
at 2 hrs got under way & stood over to Mustique
at 2 1/2 hrs came to an anchor in the upper bay of
Mustique & furled the sails

Friday 10th

Comes in with strong trades & rugged
weather Middle & latter parts much the same
at 2 hrs got under way & stood over to
town but did not anchor at 5 hrs
Anchored in Bequia harbor
Middle part heavy ~~rain~~ latter part
Pleasant weather

Saturday 11th

Comes in with moderate breezes
& good weather Middle part heavy rains
latter part pleasant weather

Sunday April 12th

3 1/2 days out
Comes in with moderate Trades
& Pleasant weather Middle part squally
with rains latter part brisk trades
at daylight got under way & stood out
into Mustique Channel at 2 1/2 hrs
lanced for Whales but did not get on

Monday 13th

Comes in with strong Trades
at 2 hrs came to an anchor in the
lower bay of Mustique with port
anchor the chain parted in bringing
up. let go the starboard anchor
fished up the port chain & shackled
it. hove up the starboard anchor
& then went on shore to cut wood
at sundown returned on board
at 1 1/2 hrs got under way & stood out into the
Channel.
