Monday April 20th

Comes in with strong Trades
Crew on Shore Hoisting
Middle Part Squally with rain
latter part strong trades & rugged
weather got under way & stood
over to Kingston where we
came to an anchor

Tuesday 21st

Comes in with brisk trades
Middle Part Squally latter part
Moderate Trades got under way
& stood over to Beaufort

Wednesday 22nd

Comes in with strong trades
Middle Part heavy squalls of wind
& rain. Employed at various jobs
of work

Thursday April 23rd

32⁷ days Out
Comes in with brisk Trades
Middle Part Squally with rain
latter part brisk Trades at daylight
got under way & stood out into
Mustique Channel. Saw nothing
to lower part

Friday 24th

Comes in with strong Trades
at 5 hrs came to an anchor in
the lower bay of Mustique, got off
some blood At 19 hrs saw whales
off shore got under way & stood out
weather squally

Saturday 25th

Comes in with brisk Trades
at 2 hrs came to an anchor in Beaufort
harbor
