Friday May 26th 356 days out
These 24 hrs pleasant weather
washed the vessel inside ready for
painting, latter part employed
painting inside

Saturday 27th
Comes in with strong trades
but pleasant weather All hands
employed painting Re Re
middle part squally with rains

Sunday 28th
Comes in with strong trades
& pleasant weather middle & latter
parts much the same

Monday 29th
Comes in with strong trades
All hands employed painting &
took starboard boat on the beach
to clean her bottom. Turned up &
painted both boats received on board a
quantity of sweet potatoes

Tuesday May 26th
Comes in with squally weather
to day finished painting. At 18 hrs got
under way & steered to N under all
sail. the islands in sight to Eastward

Wednesday 27th
Comes in with moderate trades
& pleasant weather at 5 hrs passed the
Island of Sombrero dist about 2 1/2 miles
Schr steering to N N W under all
sail middle & latter parts much the same
Lat 20 17 N

Longt per watch 4^h 54 27 W

Thursday 28th
Comes in with moderate trades
& pleasant weather at 4 hrs sent
the chains & stowed the anchors
Schr steering N N W under all sail
middle & latter parts moderate trades

Lat 22 41 N
Longt per watch 4^h 15 34
